## REQUIREMENTS FOR F1 TRANSIENT STUDENTS

F1 Transient Students are F-1 students who are not intending to transfer to CSCC but are planning to temporarily take classes for transfer back to the home school. Also indicates concurrent enrollment with the home school or enrollment at CSCC during student's vacation term. Students hold other SEVIS-approved school's I-20 and are subject to the rules and regulations imposed on them by their home school. They are not requesting I-20 from Columbus State Community College.

**International Student Advisor's Report**

The form must be completed by you and the International Student Advisor at your current college (home school).

**Please note that you will need to submit a new form for each quarter you study at CSCC as a transient student.**

**Official transcripts from any U.S. colleges you have attended** where you have completed Math and English courses. Keep a copy of any U.S. college transcripts as proof that you have met the prerequisites required for classes you wish to take at CSCC.

- If you have not completed a non-ESL English class at an U.S. college, please submit an International TOEFL score of 157 CBT, 480 PBT, 54 iBT, or a MELAB score of 78.
- Or you may take CSCC's ESL placement test (please call 614-287-2669 to make a reservation).

Submit photocopies of your F1 visa stamp, both sides of your I-94 card, and both pages of current I-20.

\*Once documents are submitted to CSCC, they will not be returned.\*
