Walk-ins available Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 8:30am-6:30pm

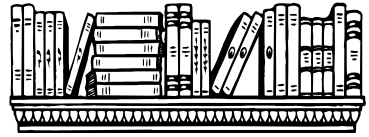
- To stay successful with your career goals:**
