The First Tee of Columbus (TFTC) is a nonprofit organization operating as a chapter under Columbus State Community College. TFTC is committed to its mission of impacting the lives of young people by providing opportunities that promote character development through the game of golf. We accomplish this mission by using an established Life Skills curriculum and golf instruction. TFTC is dedicated to helping shape and develop the lives of youth by teaching 9 core values inherent to the game of golf; honesty, integrity, respect, confidence, sportsmanship, judgment, responsibility, courtesy, & perseverance.

The First Tee of Columbus believes that while it is very beneficial to introduce young people to the game of golf, it is more important to assist them in developing the personal and social skills that will benefit them in their lives, on or off the golf course. The Life Skills component is used to teach and mentor youth on self-reliance, self-control and the ability to set and achieve goals.

In an atmosphere where learning is exciting, youth are assisted in the process of developing these traits through peer group-learning, course play, range practice, PGA instructional clinics, motivational workshops, tournament play, event exposure and educational components. Further, youth develop a sense respect, acceptance and confidence by being exposed to the etiquette expected on the golf course and the history of a game that is by most, considered elite.

The First Tee of Columbus at Bridgeview Golf Course (BVGC) is located near the intersection of Sunbury and Agler Roads. The location features a beautiful par-36, 9-hole course and full practice range. TFTC also features an indoor training facility complete with full swing stations, putting/chipping green, training aids, and a parent lounge. Program Structure and Fees

All sessions include Life Skills education and golf instruction. The instruction for each class is dependent on the age and experience level of the participants.

The following information is provided to assist you in selecting the right class for your child. At the completion of each session, the participants are individually assessed on their mastery of life skills objectives and golf skills from the class. This assessment determines their placement for the next section of classes, we allow each participant to reach their personal par.

The program sessions include: a series of six 1 ½ hour classes covering life skills and pre-shot, chipping, pitching, putting and full swing golf fundamentals. Please feel free to contact us for additional clarification and information on the sessions.

PeeWee - For youth Ages 4-6

Registration Fee: \$60

In addition to the instruction each participant will receive: driving range coupons, a shirt/hat combo, prizes and awards.

Par, Birdie and Eagle - For youth Ages 7-18

Registration Fee: \$120

In addition to the instruction each participant will receive: driving range coupons, a shirt/hat combo, prizes & awards, free admission to all TFTC workshops, access to golf equipment and the indoor training facility, discounted Bridgeview course access when accompanied by a playing adult (call BVGC for a tee time), and discounted rate to play at affiliate courses.
