Getting Started

What is u.select?

u.select is a web-based tool that allows students to plan for their academic futures by viewing courses, transfer course applicability and program requirements. Many colleges and universities nation-wide participate in u.select, and it's free for anyone to use.

To begin using u.select, simply go to the web and visit www.transfer.org then click "Get Started". This will allow you to use the basic features of u.select. More is available if you create an account.

What can I do with a u.select Account?

Users have the option of viewing course-by-course equivalencies, viewing requirements of a degree, entering and storing course work, as well as requesting an evaluation of transfer work within a program at any given participating school.

How do I begin using u.select?

1. On the web, visit transfer.org
2. Click the "Get Started" button in the center of the page.
3. You can now use the basic u.select features (more features are available if you create a u.select account.)

Using u.select

Search for Schools

The Search Schools page is a quick way for you to find information about a specific school, including the location and size of the school.

School Information Links will display a list of available web pages such as registration, admissions and financial aid information.

Locate Courses

In My Courses, those users who have a u.select account can add and save coursework to their individual account. Courses added to the My Courses profile will be used within your Plan.

Search Courses allows you to find information about courses at a specific school. This includes title, hours, course abbreviation and terms available.

View School Catalogs is another way to find course information. This provides you with a link that takes you directly to the school's online catalog.

With Equivalencies you can view how courses transfer TO a specific institution. You can do this one of two ways: by school or by course.

Explore Programs

The Search Programs page is where you can search for academic programs by subject area. *Not all schools have their programs available to be searched by subject

Browse Programs by School allows you to view all of the programs offered at a specific school.

In My Plans you can create a Plan which will show you how courses entered in My Courses apply toward the degree at the selected school. *My Plans is only available to those who have created a u.select account.
