2024 Ohio Export Internship Program



THE OPPORTUNITY:

The Ohio Export Internship Program is designed for companies looking to export for the first time or to improve their current export initiatives.

The program matches businesses with highly motivated students from Ohio universities and colleges who have taken export-focused coursework at The Ohio State University Max M. Fisher College of Business, Cleveland State University's Monte Ahuja College of Business, Youngstown State University's Williamson College of Business Administration, the University of Dayton's School of Business Administration, Bowling Green State University's Allen W. and Carol M. Schmidthorst College of Business, and Ohio University's College of Business. Participating businesses are provided a 50 percent reimbursement for intern wages. This internship program will offer a mutually beneficial relationship to students and companies by providing real-world experiences in which both can learn and grow.

Companies participating in the program must provide the following:

- · Strategic commitment to grow an export market
- Compensation for internship position
- Managerial guidance for the intern
- Existing or planned export budget
- Participation in program evaluation

- Streamlining current export processes and procedures




Ohio Export Internship Program
