
Student Achievement

A key requirement of the ACBSP accreditation mandates a systematic process which must identify and track key performance measures for continuous improvement. We are required to list key performance measures for student achievement (e.g., attrition, retention, completion, licensure pass rates, job placement, employment advancement, acceptance into degree programs, and successful transfer of credit). We are then required to provide evidence of the analysis and use of the data for continuous improvement.

Columbus State Community College will use two distinct categories for student achievement.

<u>Graduates by Program</u>: The number of students who graduated with an associate degree in each of the accredited majors offered in Business Programs.



<u>Success Rate by Program</u>: The percentage of students that obtained a successful outcome, who passed their class with a 70% or higher.
