Minutes

- 1) Information was provided to the committee regarding Stacia Edward's response to our inquiry about gathering graduate workforce data. Stacia's e-mail indicated that as part of a Straight A grant, funds were used to engage OERC at Ohio State to build a dashboard for the Central Ohio Compact. As part of that relationship, CSCC asked if it would be possible to generate an annual report that could provide graduate employment information. The OERC database includes linked data, at the individual level, between higher ed. and the labor market, so it is possible to see the labor market outcomes (by industry) for graduates at the major level by year or by cohort. The information would be aggregated thus indicating a percentage of the total experiencing a specific outcome.

While this would not be a dataset that could fill into the Success Measures section of the Program Review, it would be very informative information for the BET/H&H program review teams to analyze regarding their graduates in the Faculty Analysis section of Program Review.

- 2) The questions in the Faculty Analysis section of the Program Review form for BET/H&H we reviewed and no changes were suggested. Therefore, this form is complete and ready for Annie and her other partners in IE and IT to complete their work for the data pull in the Profile and Success Measures sections. Annie has indicated that the process may be ready for testing in 1 to 2 weeks.
- 3) The committee began the review of the Faculty Analysis sections of the AA Program Review form. In the Faculty Analysis section following the Program Profile Data, question 3, "Provide a written statement of objectives for the program etc." will be removed. The rest of the question in that section have been approved.
- 4) In review of the Faculty Analysis section following the Success Measures there was a discussion regarding question 2 and if this question about tutoring opportunities should be broader capturing the High Impact Practices discussed by Dr. Harrison at the Spring In-Service Day. Further, this may impact the way the Success Measure 1.7 is written if such data can be pulled. There also was some concern regarding how the College Credit Plus data will be pulled for analysis. Polly will investigate both of these issue prior to the August 8th meeting.
