## P&T Tidbit - Peer Review Teams (PRTs)

- All tenure track faculty navigating the P&T process are required to have
  a Peer Review Team. This exempts full professors and others not navigating the P&T
  process.
- PRTs are made up of two faculty senior to the candidate, from the candidate's department (or a related department if necessary). Chairs may suggest, but not appoint PRTs
- It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure a PRT is assembled, seek PRT help with P&T portfolios, and assure that their PRT includes comments and signs the Annual Appraisal each spring.
- PRTs are also often the faculty who **conduct Classroom Observations** (find current forms on the P&T webpage linked below).
