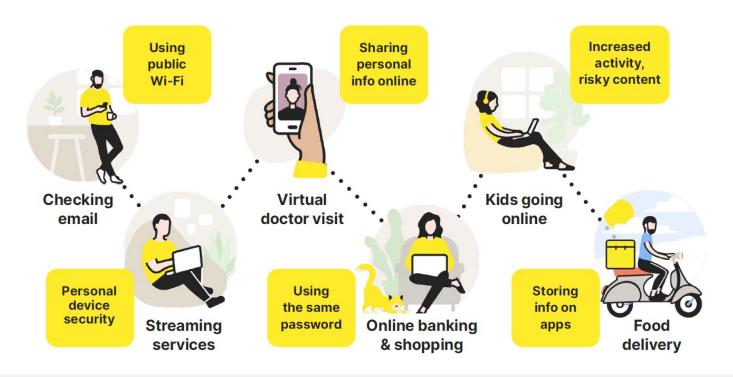

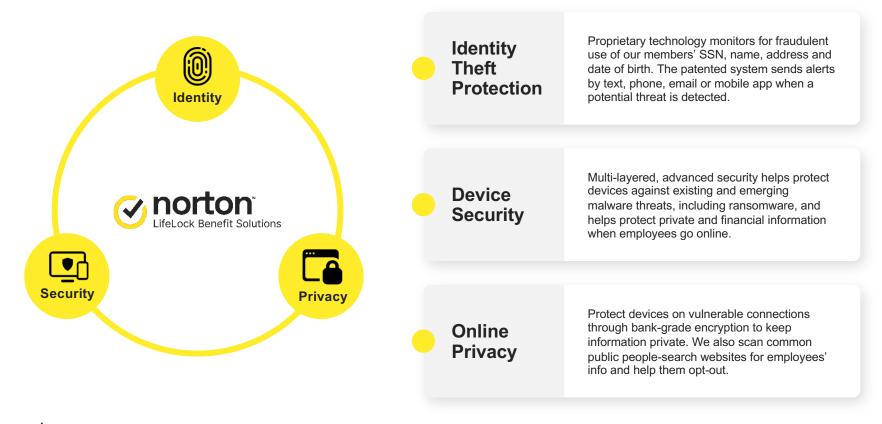


The average amount of times Americans check their phones (once every 4 minutes)

of passwords are duplicated across work and personal accounts



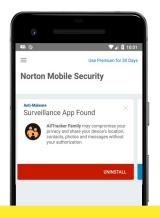

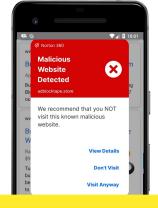

BLOCK & LOCK

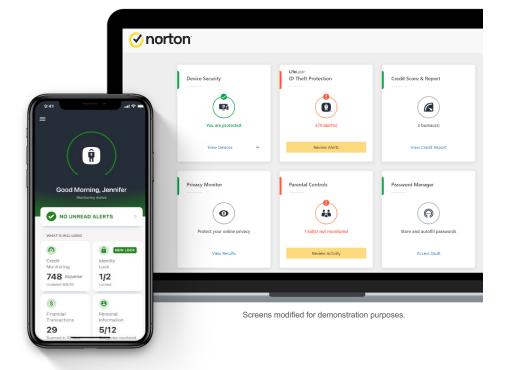

Tips To Stay Safe While Online

- Install Norton on devices that are not protected. When away from your computer, lock it.
- Update passwords frequently; Best Practices- Password Manager
- Secure your home router with a strong password (not default credentials).
- Hover over link to see where if it is safe; don't click unknown links
- Use two- factor when possible
- Be aware of online requests for personal information
- Slow down and be aware of emails & websites; don't click unknown links
- Watch for spelling and grammar mistakes in emails and on website
- Check on your children's online activities frequently; they are less aware of scams and phishing
- Educate your elderly parents about possible threats
- Be aware of unwanted calls- even if Caller ID lists "Social Security"
- Turn off location on cell phone/ turn off Autofill
